ONE 18 KARAT WHITE GOLD MOUNTING (BRACELET), MEASURING APPROX. 7 3/4 INCHES IN OVERALL LENGTH, WEIGHING IN TOTAL APPROX. 86.1 DWT., STAMPED "750" WITH LOGO, CONTAINING NUMEROUS TRANSPARENT STRAIGHT BAGUETTE CUT AND ROUND BRILLIANT STONES AND NUMEROUS RED TRANSPARENT OVAL SHAPE STONES AND ONE NATURAL CORUNDUM - RUBY, OVAL MIXED CUT, MEASURING APPROX. 6.80 x 4.80 x 3.15 MM., WEIGHT ESTIMATED BY FORMULA 0.9333 CARAT, COLOR: PURPLISH RED TRANSPARENT.

COMMENTS:

GRADED AS MOUNTING PERMITS. NATURAL RUBIES ARE COMMONLY ENHANCED AS PART OF THEIR NORMAL FASHIONING PROCESS. EVIDENCE OF HEAT TREATMENT PRESENT WITH MINOR RESIDUE IN FISSURES. BASED ON CURRENT GEMOLOGICAL INFORMATION, THE RUBY DESCRIBED ABOVE WOULD BE CLASSIFIED AS BEING OF BURMA ORIGIN. THIS IDENTIFICATION REPORT IS FOR AUTHENTICATION PURPOSES.
