Description:

Examined:

- 1) Loose, oval, faceted, transparent blue gemstone; 2.40 ct; 8.0 x 7.0 x 4.2 mm
 - 2) Loose, oval, faceted, transparent yellow gemstone; 2.00 ct 7.6 x 6.9 x 4.2 mm
 - 3) Part-drilled, iridescent grey/brown, button 'pearl'; 7.1 mm in width, depth~5.5 – 6 mm
 - 4) Three part-drilled, button 'pearls'; Largest: 5.1 mm in width
 - 5) 12 round drilled, cream/white to yellow 'pearls'; Largest: 4.4 mm in width
- mounted with numerous eight-cut, colourless stones on a pendant chain necklace with a ring bolt clasp

Weight of item: 12.06 grams
